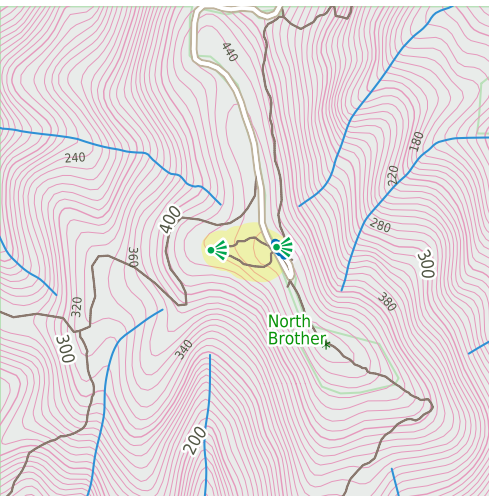

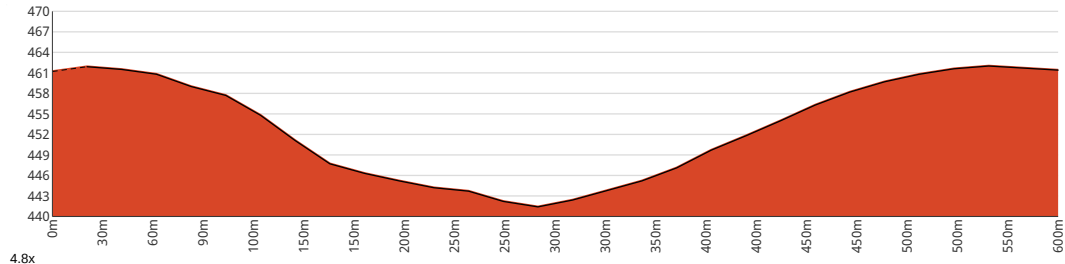

Hard track



This circuit walk in Dooragan National Park starts at North Brother summit picnic area and takes you to the Diamond Head lookout. The northern part of the loop is accessible. The southern part leads through a lush rainforest.



Class: 4/6, Hard track

Quality of track	Smooth and hardened path (1/6)
Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Minimal directional signs (4/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities (such as cliffs not fenced, significant creeks not bridged) (4/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Foretasted & unexpected storms and severe weather may impact on navigation and safety (4/6)

Getting there : From Ocean Drive, West Haven, head south-west along Captain Cook Bicentennial Drive;

- After 4.6km, come to the trackhead on Captain Cook Bicentennial Drive North Brother.

Before you start ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have the equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures, fire dangers and foreseeable risks
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

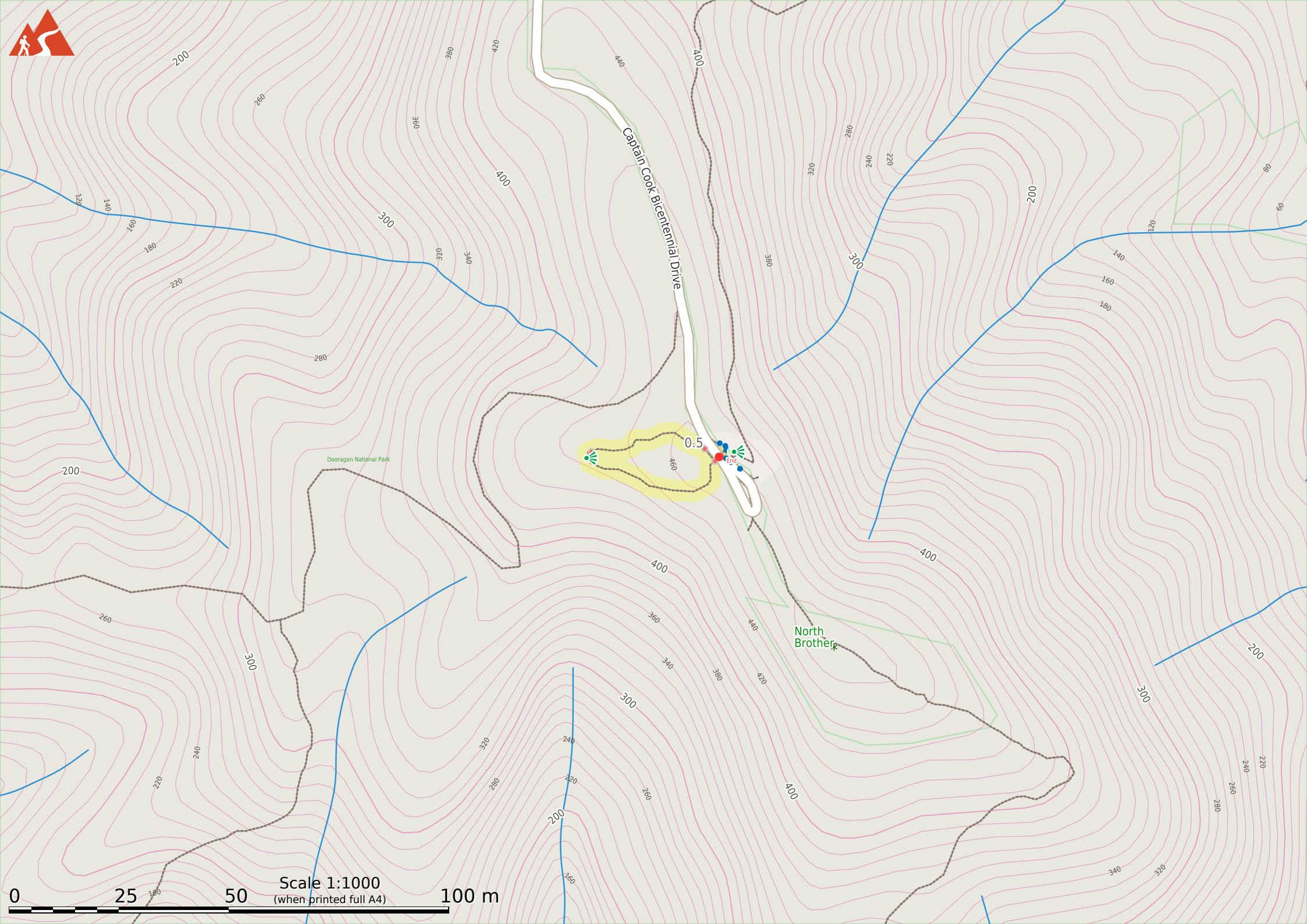
If not, postpone or change plans and stay safe. Ask people for help.

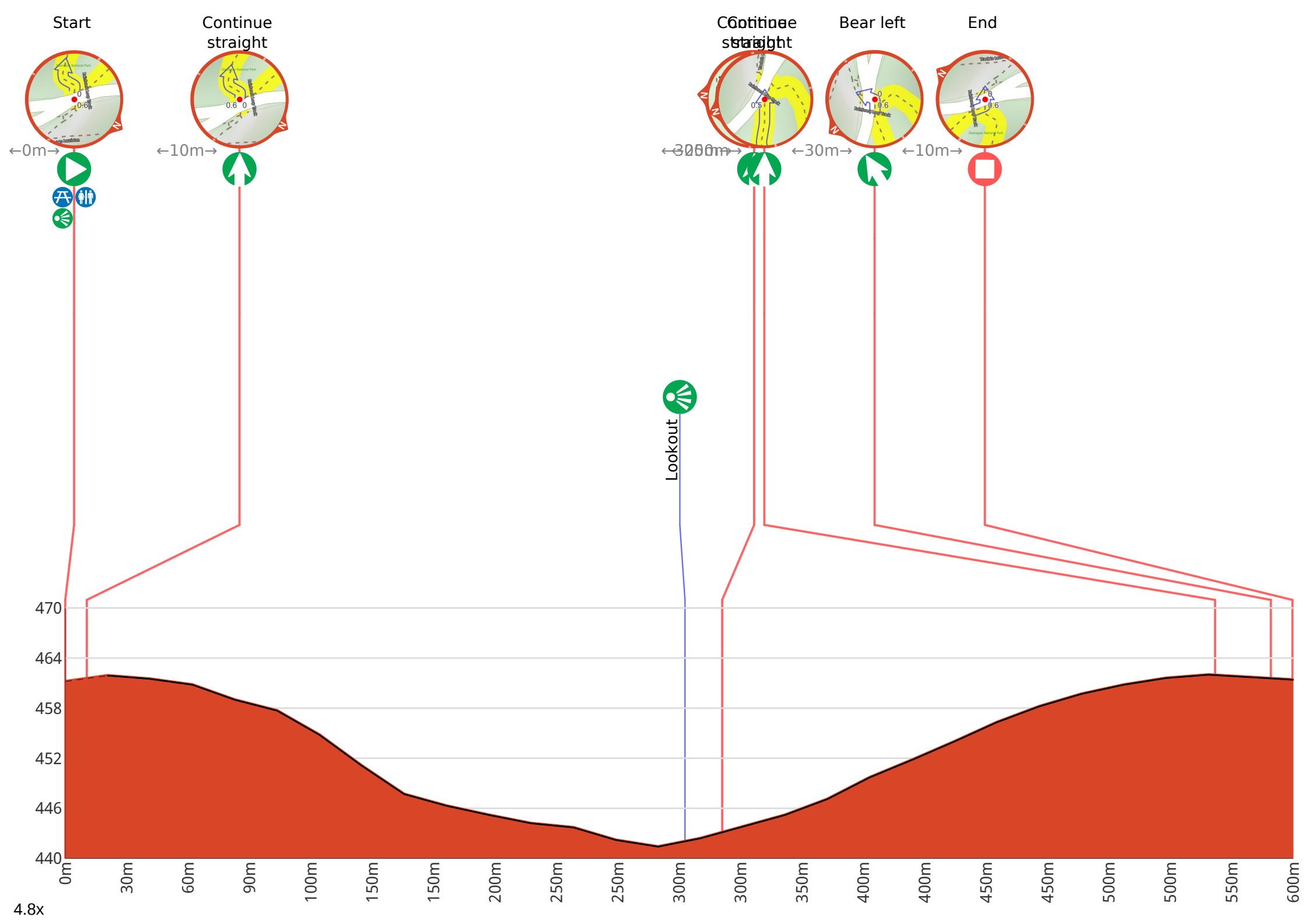
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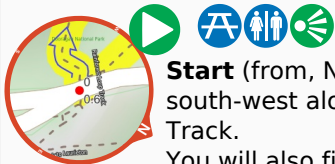

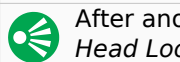




Start (from, North Brother) by heading south-west along the Rainforest Loop Track.
You will also find a picnic table, toilet and a lookout here.



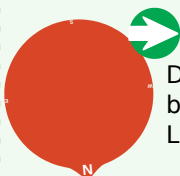
Then almost immediately (at the 3-way intersection, with & Rainforest Loop Track) **continue straight**, to follow the Rainforest Loop Track.



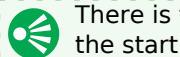
After another 300m you will find the *Diamond Head Lookout* (on your right).

Start of optional sidetrip

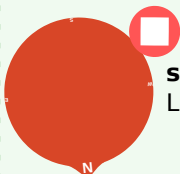
Side trip to Diamond Head lookout with views.



To start this sidetrip **turn right** (from Diamond Head Lookout, North Brother) by heading south along the Rainforest Loop Track.

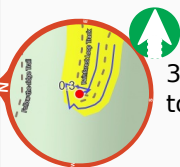


There is the *Diamond Head Lookout*, lookout at the start.

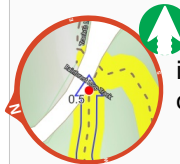


Then almost immediately this **sidetrip ends** at Diamond Head Lookout, North Brother.

When you have finished this side trip, head back to the main route and bear right to continue.



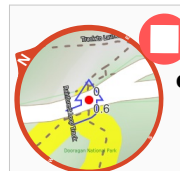
Then almost immediately (at the 3-way intersection) **continue straight**, to stay on the Rainforest Loop Track.



After another 250m, (at the 3-way intersection) **continue straight**, to stay on the Rainforest Loop Track.



After another 30m, (at the 3-way intersection) **bear left**, to stay on the Rainforest Loop Track.



After another 10m you come to **the end**, North Brother.
