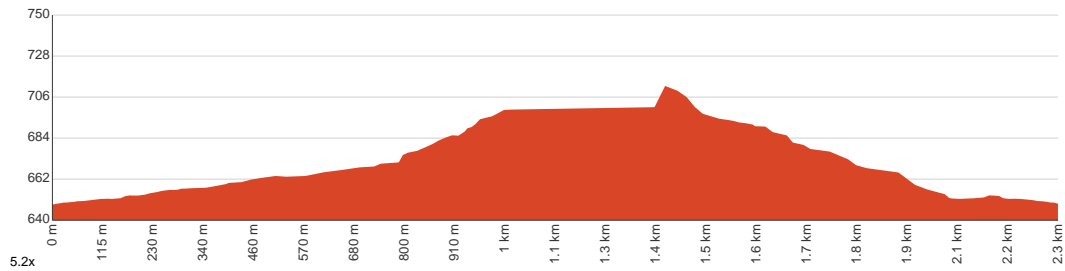
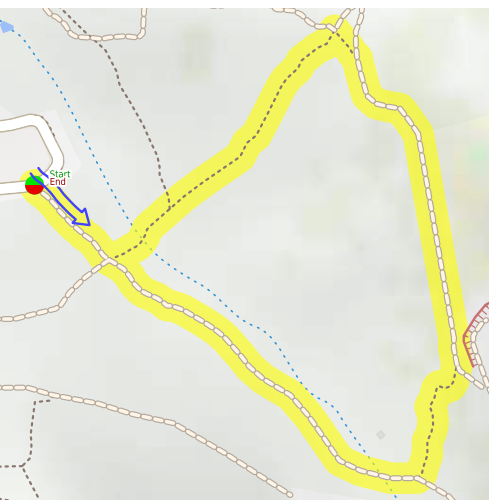

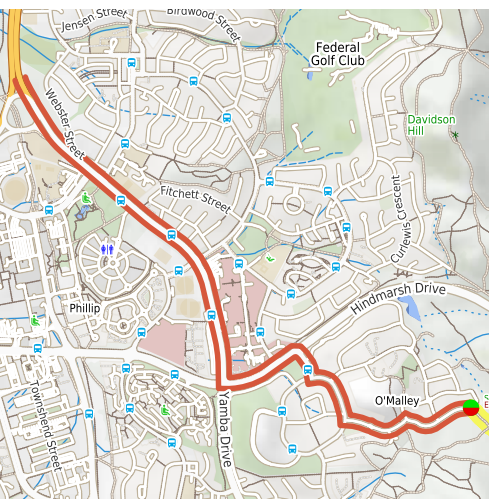
Mount Mugga Mugga Western Circuit is a circuit walk starting from the Akame Circuit in O'Malley, crossing a stream (bed) twice via fords. This walk takes you through the Mount Mugga Mugga Nature Reserve, a natural landscape filled with wildlife such as kangaroos and rabbits. You can also birdwatch here, as the reserve is home to many interesting bird species like the Rainbow Lorikeet. From time to time, views of Jerrabombera and Woden valleys can be seen through the trees. This walk is pet friendly (on-lead), so feel free to bring your furry friends along. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.



Class 3 of 6 Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles	
Quality of track	Clear and well formed track or trail (2/6)
Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Directional signs along the way (3/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (2/6)
Experience Required	Some bushwalking experience recommended (3/6)
Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (2/6)

Getting to the start: From Yarra Glen, Hughes.

- Turn on to Yamba Drive then drive for 2.2 km
- Turn left onto Hindmarsh Drive and drive for another 480 m
- Keep right onto Tyagarah Street and drive for another 225 m
- Turn left onto Culgoa Circuit and drive for another 380 m
- Turn left onto Callemonda Rise and drive for another 410 m
- Turn right onto Akame Circuit and drive for another 440 m



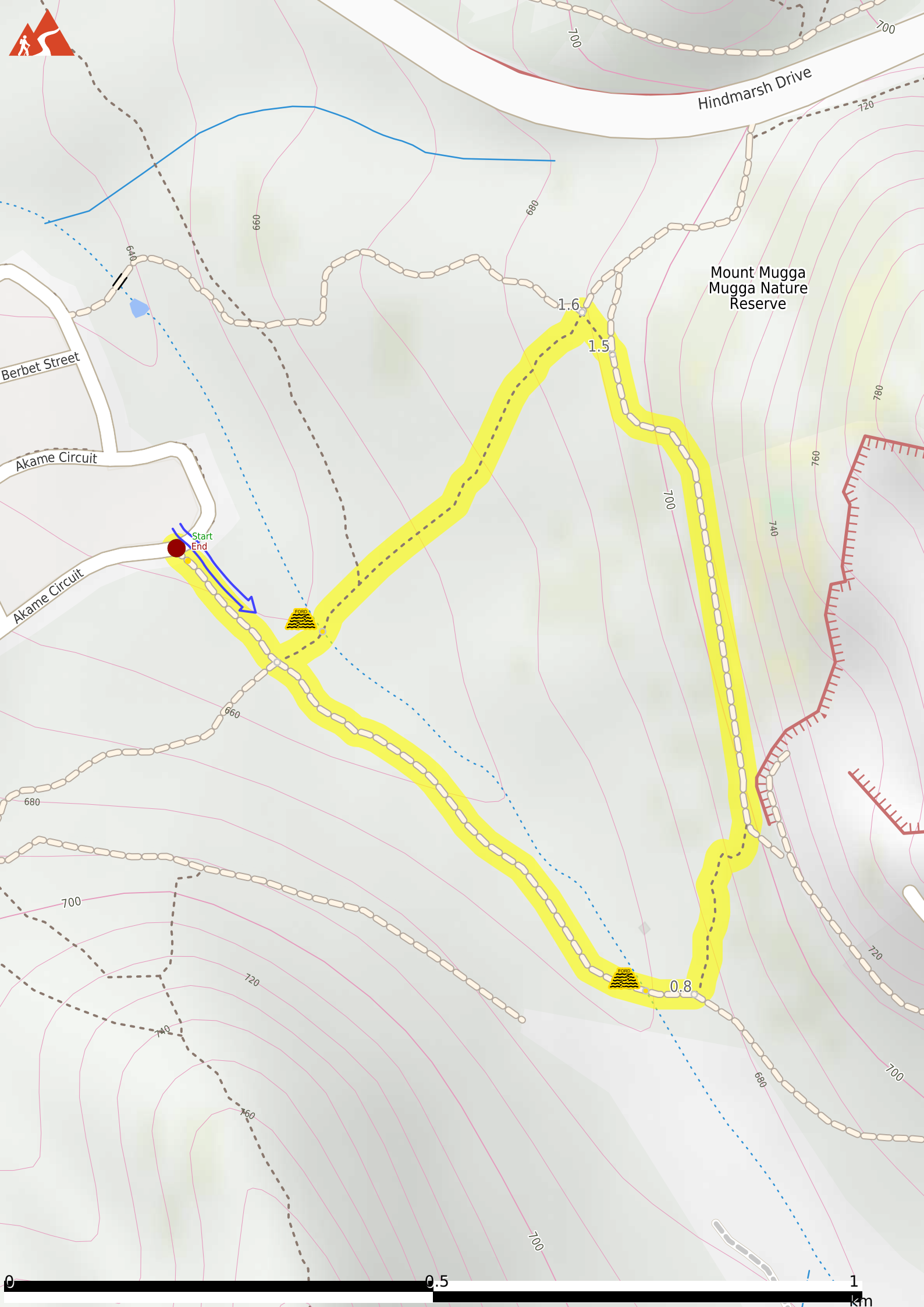
Before you start any journey ensure you;




Getting started: From Akame Circuit (220 metres northwest of the intersection with Dalman Street), head towards the metal gate marked by the green "Canberra Nature Park - Mount Mugga Mugga" sign. Head over/around the gate and pass by a sheltered signpost (to your left) as you head along the subtle trail. About 170 metres in, continue straight at the 4-way intersection to continue along Mount Mugga Mugga Western Circuit (counterclockwise).




From the Akame Circuit **Start** (a vehicle track).



After 30 m head through/around the gate.



After another 140 m **continue straight**.




After another 10 m **continue straight**.




After another 590 m cross the ford.




Continue straight.




After another 55 m **veer left**.




After another 210 m **continue straight**.




After another 540 m **veer left**.




After another 55 m **turn left**.




After another 390 m **continue straight**.




After another 75 m cross the ford.



Continue straight.



After another 65 m **veer right**.



Continue another 165 m to find from the Akame Circuit at the end.
