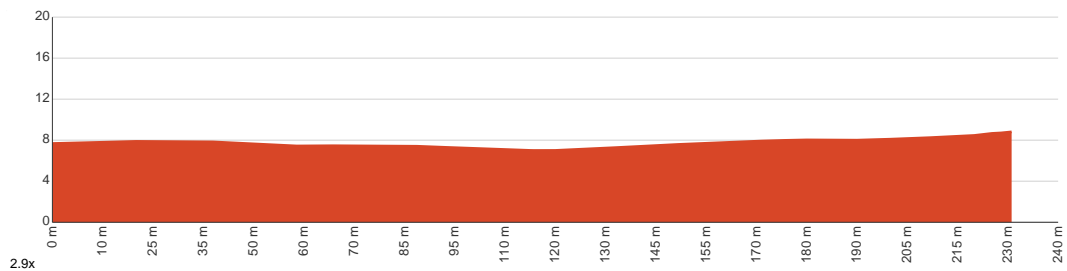

Starting from the small car park at the intersection of Lady Game Dr & Grosvenor Rd, Lindfield, this lovely boardwalk leads you through the tall Blue Gum forest beside a pleasant small creek. For most of the walk, you are unaware of the nearby roads. Gaze up at the towering trees and sit to enjoy the creek as it slowly meanders along the valley floor. There is a long bench seat partway through, and the boardwalk widens in areas to allow easy passing and space to enjoy the lush natural bushland. The end of the boardwalk loops around a sculpture designed to provide habitat for microbats; you can learn more about these amazing creatures with the signs along the way before turning around to return to the car park. Let us begin by acknowledging the Darramuragal people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Naturally Accessible

Slope summary: The walk is generally flat. The steepest incline 7.8% (4.5°) near the start is staged over ~25m with handrails. There is also ~15m of handrails about 40m later and another 10m of handrails about 50m after that.

Surface summary: The first ~25m follows a 1.7m wide asphalt path, then the walk follows a boardwalk (FRP grating, 1cm square holes) generally 1.7m wide (expanding to 3.5m at four places) the rest of the way.

Getting to the start: From Pacific Highway, A1, Lindfield.

- Turn on to Grosvenor Road then drive for 430 m
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Grosvenor Road and drive for another 235 m
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Grosvenor Road and drive for another 130 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Grosvenor Road and drive for another 820 m
- Turn sharp right and drive for another 25 m

Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
 - Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
 - Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
 - Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
 - Are healthy and fit enough for this journey
- If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.

Getting started: From the small car park at the intersection of Lady Game Dr & Grosvenor Rd, Lindfield, start this walk by following the asphalt path directly away from the roundabout, past the timber bollards, gently downhill and along the boardwalk into the Blue Gum forest.



i After 195 m pass the "Microbats" (on your left).



♿ After another 5 m pass a seat (on your right). This wooden seat is 4 m long, 47 cm tall, 38 cm wide, has no armrest and has no backrest.



♿ After another 30 m come to "A Microbat Safe Haven".
