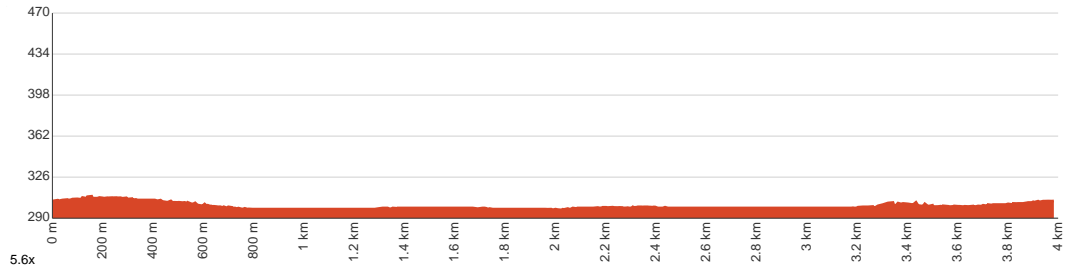
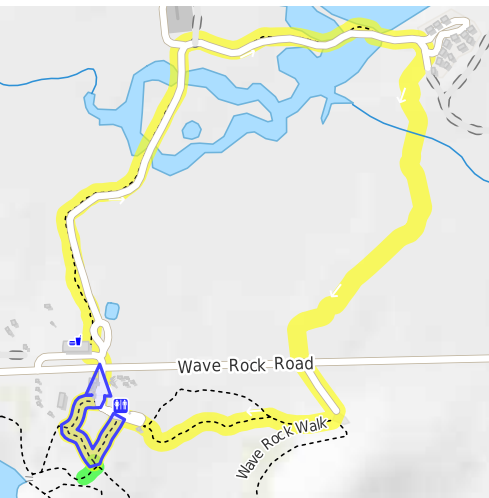

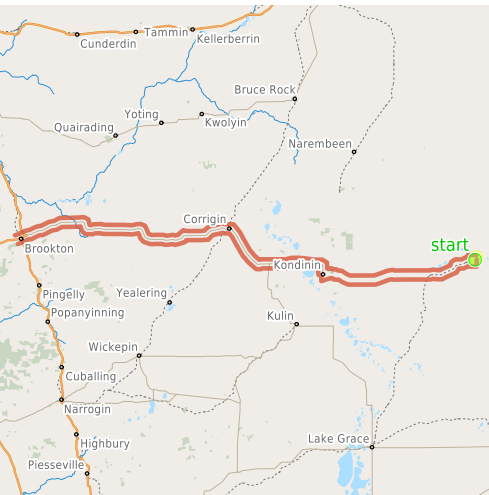
Starting from Wave Rock Caravan Park, Hyden, this walk takes you on an informative circuit about Aboriginal history and visits salt lakes along the way. The area is quite photogenic because of the impact of salt lakes on the environment. Even though they are detrimental, the dry trees due to excessive levels of salt create an eerie atmosphere that can be exhilarating during the sunrise and sunset. After rainfall, the lakes allow the area to become a watery wonderland as well. The walk is also universally accessible with a flat surface, and cycling is allowed. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From Brookton Highway, 40, Brookton.

- Turn on to Howlett Street then drive for 2 km
- Turn left onto Kondinin Hyden Road, 40 and drive for another 60.6 km
- Turn left onto Lovering Road and drive for another 1 km
- Turn right onto Wave Rock Road and drive for another 1.1 km
- Turn right onto Wave Rock Road and drive for another 125 m
- Keep right and drive for another 35 m



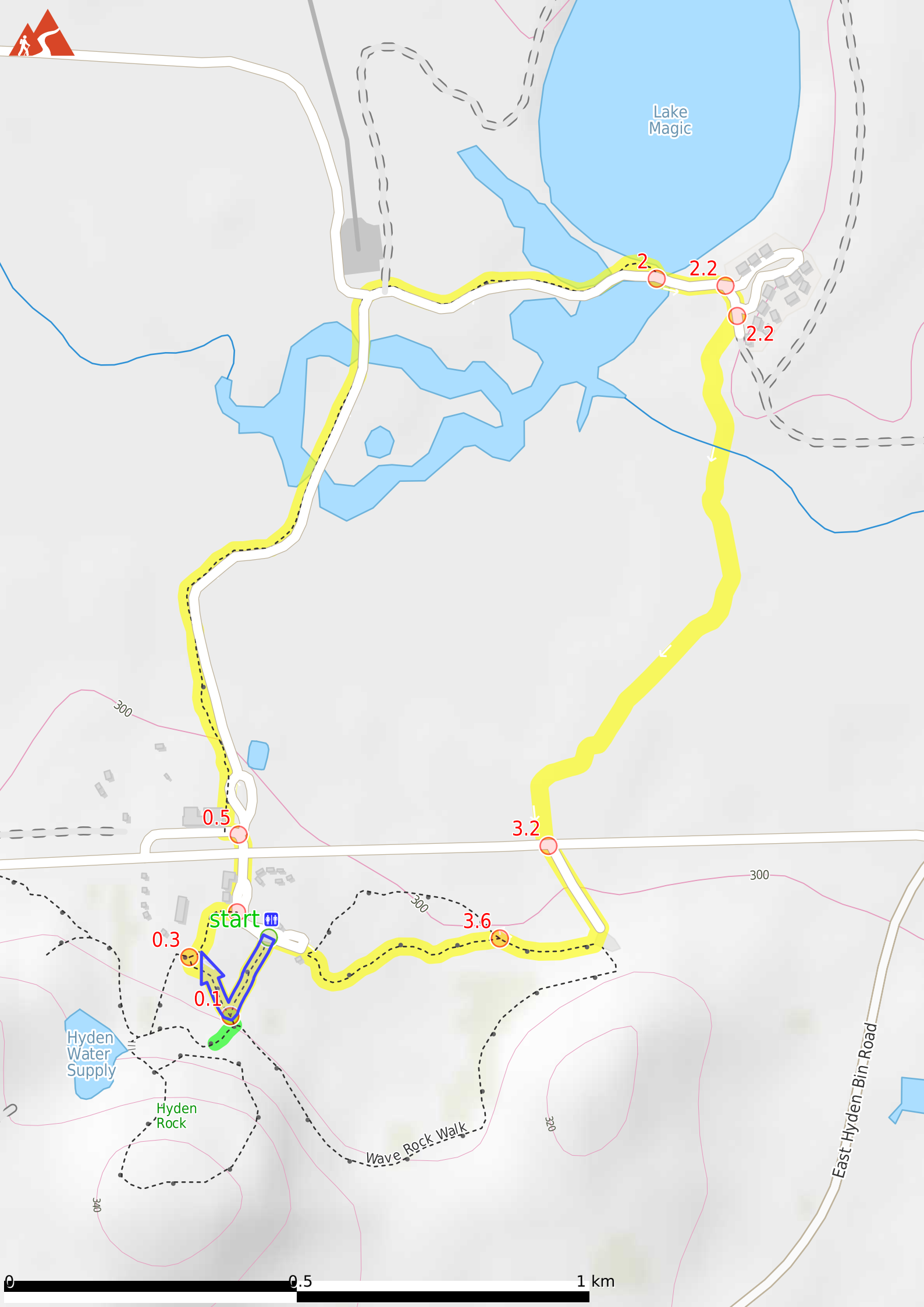
Before you start any journey ensure you;

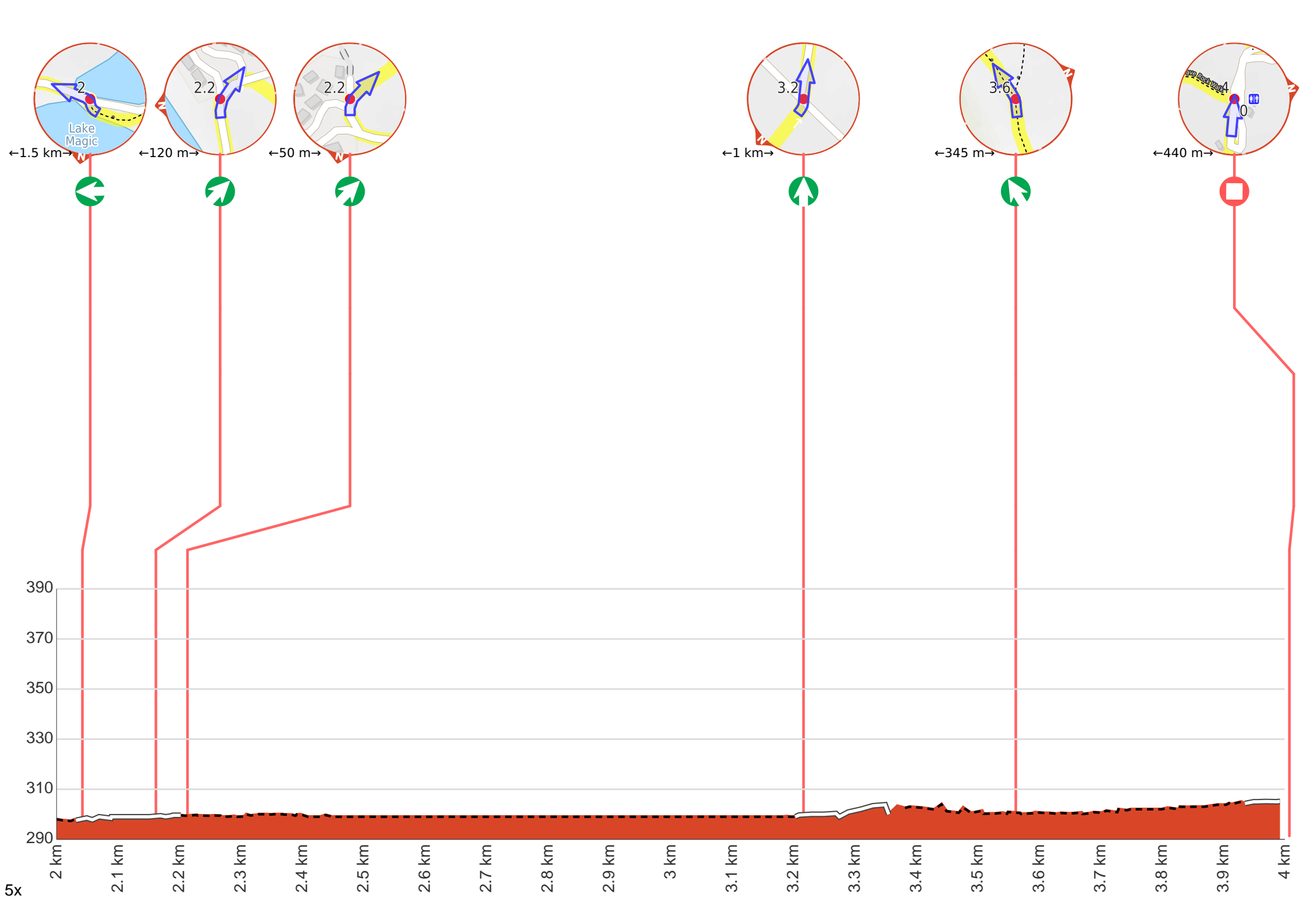
- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning

- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

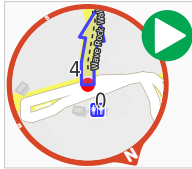
If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.

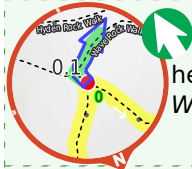




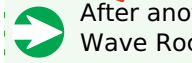


Start heading along *Wave Rock Walk*.

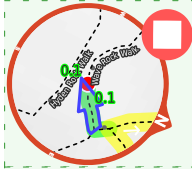
Start of an optional side trip: An optional side trip taking you to the Wave Rock.



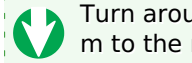
To start this optional side trip veer left here. **Start** heading along *Wave Rock Walk*.



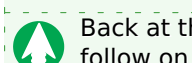
After another 15 m **turn right**, to head along *Wave Rock Walk*.



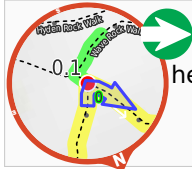
After another 45 m come to the end.



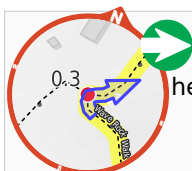
Turn around and retrace your steps back the 60 m to the main route.



Back at the main route continue straight and follow on from the 135 m waypoint.



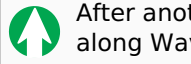
After another 135 m **turn right**, to head along *Wave Rock Walk*.



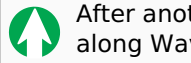
After another 120 m **turn right**, to head along *Wave Rock Walk*.



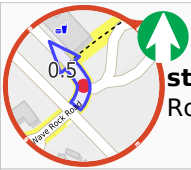
After another 125 m **turn left**.



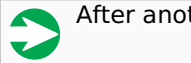
After another 50 m **continue straight**, to head along *Wave Rock Road*.



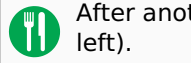
After another 40 m **continue straight**, to head along *Wave Rock Road*.



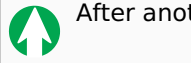
After another 30 m **continue straight**, to head along *Wave Rock Road*.



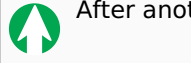
After another 25 m **turn right**.



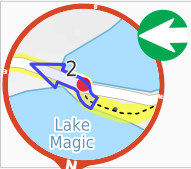
After another 25 m pass the cafe (20 m on your left).



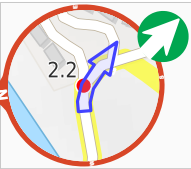
After another 950 m **continue straight**.



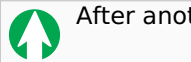
After another 35 m **continue straight**.



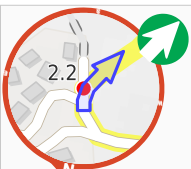
After another 500 m **turn left**.



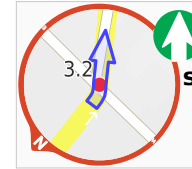
After another 120 m **veer right**.



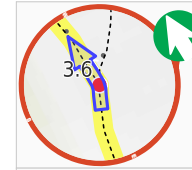
After another 35 m **continue straight**.

After another 345 m **veer left**.



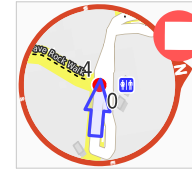
After another 390 m **continue straight**.
